

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Friday, March 13, 2020

The Board of Supervisors convened at 9:00 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Rachel Foster and Mark Walk. Motion by Smolik, second by Walk to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

The Chair opened the public hearing for the proposed property tax levy for FY 20/21. The Auditor reviewed the proposed maximum property tax for FY 2020/2021. The General Services requested tax dollars increased by 3.46 % from FY 2019/2020 and the requested tax dollars from Rural Services increased by 2.24% from FY 2019/2020. No comments were received prior to the public hearing. After discussion the public hearing was closed at 9:05 a.m.

Motion by Walk, second by Smolik to approve Resolution #1056-20 to levy the budgeted tax dollars. All voted aye.

County Attorney Mark Walk discussed procedure to determine which Supervisor Districts will be on the 2020 Primary/General Ballots for 4-year terms and which will be for 2-year terms. County Attorney is asking Judge Schroeder to draw the districts by lot from a bowl. He will put a notice in the Press News and the numbers will be drawn on March 24th.
