

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, March 24, 2020

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with Francis and Walk present. Smolik was ill. Also present were Chuck Pajer, Casey Ketelsen and Rachel Foster. Due to the Corona Virus the meeting was made available to the public by video via "Go to Meeting" Motion by Walk, second by Francis to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Walk, second by Francis to approve the minutes of the March 17th and the claims. All voted aye.

County Attorney Mark Walk didn't have anything to discuss.

Due to the Corona Virus future Board meetings will be available electronically by logging on to Go to Meeting. Discussed health and economic issues due to the Corona Virus. County may step up and help out those who are in need. County Attorney said that this would serve as a Public Purpose.

Lots were drawn by Chuck Pajer for the five Supervisor Districts. Districts 1 and 3 will be two-year terms and Districts 2, 4 and 5 will be four-year terms. These will be on the 2020 Primary and General Election ballots.

Sheriff Greg Beaver stated that mobile testing for the Corona Virus will be Thursday, March 26th from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Mitchell County Fair Grounds. The Sheriff's Department will be delivering the tests to the State Hygienic Lab.

Items of note: Francis reported on the North Iowa Community Action, Iowa Workforce Development, Economic Development, County Social Services and Corona Virus meetings. Walk reported on the Corona Virus meeting. Discussed Board appointments for NIACOG and NIRHA.

County Engineer Rich Brumm stated the Roads Department are removing snow equipment. Discussed Melissa Tusler working from home due to an under lying health condition. Discussed future paving projects.
