Tuesday, October 20, 2020

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Chuck Pajer, Samantha Scharper, Bruce Biederman, Dave Stauffer, Mike Mayer and Keith Horgen. Steve Thompson was present from the Media. Due to the COVID 19 the meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Smolik, second by Walk to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Walk, second by Smolik to approve the minutes of the October 13th meeting. All voted aye.

County Attorney Mark Walk stated that the Kephart trial is scheduled for October 30th at 10:00 a.m.

Motion by Smolik, second by Walk to approve the September Sheriff Report of Fees collected in the amount of \$8,789.26. All voted aye.

County Engineer Rich Brumm reported that the Roads department is putting on snow equipment. Quotes for an excavator were delayed for one week. Rich provided a summary of County paving within City Limits from 2009-2020.

Motion by Smolik, second by Walk to approve the Auditor's Quarterly Report of Revenue collected in the amount of \$177.00. All voted aye.

Motion by Walk, second by Smolik to approve the Recorder's Quarterly Report of Fees collected in the amount of \$23,762.73. All voted aye.

Smolik reported on the FMC Landfill, Hazmat, NCRERC and North Iowa Juvenile Detention meetings. Walk reported on the Conservation and T21 meetings.
