The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Chuck Pajer, Randy Conrad, Rita Dvorak, Chrystal Berche, Casey Ketelsen and State Representative Jane Bloomingdale. Motion by Francis, second by Walk to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Francis, second by Walk to approve the minutes of the September 3rd meeting and the claims. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Discussed with County Attorney Mark Walk a requirement for seat belt usage on NIACOG Transit buses.

County Engineer Rich Brumm reviewed a quote for two 2020 dump trucks. Total package cost with trade in's from Nuss Trucks is \$239,965.00. Motion by Walk, second by Francis to purchase the two dump trucks. Roll call vote: all voted aye. Discussed hiring three new employees. This will be placed on the September 17th agenda for approval.
