

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, September 22, 2020

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Chuck Pajer, Samantha Scharper, Bruce Biederman, Dave Stauffer and Gloria Brincks. Steve Thompson was present from the Media. Due to the COVID 19 the meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Smolik, second by Walk to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Walk, second by Smolik to approve the minutes of the September 15th meeting and the claims. All voted aye.

County Attorney Mark Walk stated that there will be a public hearing on October 13th at 8:45 a.m. to sell County property to Randi Johnson.

Motion by Smolik, second by Walk to approve the Sheriff's Report for August in the amount of \$22,897.52. All voted aye.

County Engineer Rich Brumm informed the BOS about a DOT Bridge Program Grant. Rich is working with WHKS to see if Mitchell County will qualify. September 30th is the deadline for the grant. Supervisor Walk stated that the intersection of Foothill Avenue and Mitchell Line Street does not have stop or yield sign to control the traffic. Rich stated that he didn't think that this is designated as thru route at this time. He will check into this.

Treasurer Shannon Paulus presented two tax suspension orders for the BOS to consider. The suspension requests are directed from the Department of Human Services. Motion by Walk, second by Smolik to approve suspending the special assessment taxes of Francis Balk and suspending the property taxes of Bradley Prigge. All voted aye.

Home Health/Public health will be giving flu shots to Courthouse employees on Tuesday, October 13th in the Courthouse break room starting at 9:00 a.m.

Items of note: Francis reported on the Board of Health, NE Iowa Workforce and North Iowa Community Action meetings. Smolik reported on the FMC DECAT, FMC Landfill and FMC Early Childhood meetings Walk reported that Myrtle Nelson has been hired as the new NIACOG Director. She will take over this position January 1, 2021. Walk also reported that the can redemption money goes to the Mitchell County Land Acquisition Fund. Received the Clerk of Court Report for August in the amount of 1,980.31.
