

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, September 8, 2020

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Chuck Pajer, Samantha Scharper, Bruce Biederman, Dave Stauffer, Gary Fossey, Rachel Foster, Randy Conrad and Mike Mayer. Savannah Howe and Steve Thompson were present from the Media. Due to the COVID 19 the meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Smolik, second by Walk to include portable building and to approve the amended agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Walk, second by Smolik to approve the minutes of the September 1st meeting and the claims. All voted aye.

County Attorney Mark Walk had nothing to report and Sheriff Greg Beaver had nothing to report.

County Engineer Rich Brumm stated that the tile crossing has been completed.

County Auditor Lowell Tesch discussed a proposal from Cott Systems to digitize the Auditor's Property Transfer books. This will be placed on next week's agenda for possible approval.

Supervisor Walk asked permission from the other BOS members to look for a portable building that could be used at the County Recycling Center to count cans. He is looking for a building either 8' or 10' wide and 14' long. The building would be paid for from the Recycling Center budget. Consensus of the Board to have Walk look for a portable building.

Items of note: Francis reported on two County Social Service HR meetings and a NE Iowa Workforce meeting. Walk reported on the Upper Cedar Watershed and Homeward Housing meetings and also doing interviews to hire a new NIACOG Director. Received manure management plan updates from the Friesen 5 Site and the Wheeler Finisher Farm.
